Corning approached the City of Ann Arbor and offered a 25 year warranty if we allowed Corning to oversee the quality of the construction work. This warranty was being offered at no charge as long as Corning products are used, and they are. The City was seeking vendors to purchase inside plant equipment and received quotes, but Turnkey offered to purchase the equipment because they could obtain a better price than the City.
