**Subject:** Comments w/r/t 904 S. Main St. Proposal

Dear Ann Arbor City Planning Commission,

My main concern with the proposed project is high-decibel construction noise. Those in the immediate vicinity of the proposed project have already endured over one year of construction noise from the project immediately adjacent to this one.

Contractors often work up to (and even beyond) 8:00pm--which they are entitled to under the city ordinance. However, I ask that the Commission please consider restricting high-decibel construction noise at this project to between 8:30am-5:00pm.

It will be a small burden to the general contractor to stop noisy work (e.g. heavy machinery, loader-shovel operation, etc.) at 5:00pm, but that does not seem too much to ask given (i) this is a relatively small set of condominiums and (ii) as mentioned earlier, the quality of life in the neighborhood has already been negatively impacted by ongoing work on the lot immediately adjacent.

The proposed condominiums will no doubt increase the value of property nearby and brighten the neighborhood once complete. I ask only that, in the meantime, those of us who live here finally be able to come home and relax--to peace and quiet--at 5:00pm, after a long day at work.
