AMENDMENT NUMBER 01 TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN MALCOLM PIRNIE, INC (ARCADIS) AND THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The additional fee to be paid the Consultant for the additional services specified in **EXHIBIT A-1** is \$728,902.99.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties executed January 30, 2012, unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this amendment and are made a part of this amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This amendment to the agreement between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
