# 1. Lisa Abrams - Guns in Our Parks

Lisa Abrams, 2745 Ember Way, spoke about the City's deer cull. She expressed concern about the City's signage warning of sharp shooters in a wildlife sanctuary, noting the hypocrisy of the words.

#### 2. Lorraine Shapiro - Deer Cull

Lorraine Shapiro, 1484 Green Road, spoke in opposition to the City's deer cull. She also stated the City's published list of deer cull sites is inaccurate and misleading.

Councilmember Lumm spoke about the Rainbow Child Care Site Plan postponement and the request for the Ann Arbor Public Schools to review the item, as well as her previous request for additional traffic impact studies.

Councilmember Lumm spoke about the DTE Apex Substation project on Huron Parkway and the postponement of the curb cut item from December 18. She asked if Friday's Work Session would also cover these topics.

Councilmember Lumm expressed disappointment regarding the City Administrator's memo outlining the inability of the City to coordinate the DTE transmission line project during the Nixon Road corridor construction project.
