Action Item #1: August 8, 2017 Agenda

Change to Agenda, remove Discussion Item #3 - Oak at 2222 Packard from agenda. Don Wortman moved to approve August 8, 2017 agenda, as amended; Merrill Dudley seconded the motion. Committee unanimously approved.

Action Item #2: Approve July 11, 2017 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Wortman moved to approve July 11, 2017 meeting minutes; Edi Bletcher seconded the **motion.** Committee unanimously approved.

Information Item #1: FY 17 & FY 18 Budget and Project Update

To date, FY17 (July 1 2016-June 30, 2017) expenditures are approximately \$48,000, however, all FY17 expenses have not been posted. The final FY17 expenses will be provided at the next meeting

Discussion Item #1: Veteran's Memorial Park Sign and Landscaping

Hillary Hanzel, the City's park planner, provided an updated landscape plan for Veteran's Memorial Park based on comments from the July Dean Fund Committee meeting. The Dean Fund can only pay for activities related to tree planting and care and the Park Millage will cover the other costs. The project would be completed by late spring 2018.

Mr. Wortman moved to approve a not to exceed budget of \$10,000 for the tree planting and care portion of the Veteran's Memorial Park project. Ms. Bletcher seconded the motion. Committee unanimously approved.

At a future meeting, the Committee would like to discuss removing the crabapple street trees along Maple Road along Veteran's Park and replacing with bigger trees.

Discussion Item #2: Champion Tree Program

Systems Planning Forestry Intern, Clare Kucera, presented on the revival of the City's Champion Tree program. Ms. Kucera spent the summer verifying the trees that were on the original Champion Tree List from the 1990's. Based on verification of the existing trees and identification of new Champion Trees, Ms. Kucera created an interactive map using ESRI's Story Map application. The Story Map will be available for viewing on the City's website once property owners with Champion Trees have provided permission to include their location on the map. Anticipated release of the Champion Tree map is late 2017-early 2018.

Information Item #2: Routine Street Tree Pruning Cycle

Kerry Gray provided information on the City restarting its routine street tree pruning cycle. Based on available resources, the cycle will be 10 years, which means each street tree will be pruned once every 10 years.
