I live a block off Pontiac Trail on Brookside Drive and our neighborhood has several families like ours with a disabled and/or elderly member, some of whom are low income African American families who have lived there for 50 years.

Everyone I have spoken to is very worried about the Trinitas development. I care for my husband full time and have not kept informed enough, but I am very concerned about how life will change out here. We have been able to take my husband out in his motorized wheel chair because of the slow moving traffic. I am a lifelong Ann Arborite. We moved out here to live in a ranch when our two story downtown home would no longer work for us due to my husband's no longer being able to use stairs. We have watched the traffic get much heavier with the changes so far and are not sure how Pontiac Trail could accommodate the impact of very dense housing/transportation needs-- we hope the planning commission will try to look at a better balance in the make up of the new development.

Thank you for your service and for trying to safeguard the quality of life for everyone as best you can.
