- During the FY20/21 budget process, City staff will take a deep dive into the means and methods of service delivery and coordination of core services with strategic plans.



Climate Action Funding (County Millage)

- City will be rebated ~\$2.2M from the County Public Safety and Community Mental Health millage beginning in FY19
- Council has designated 40% to be dedicated to Climate Action programs. A total
 of \$75,000 is programmed in FY19, the balance will go into a dedicated account.
