Request for new Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with authorization to sell spirits and mixed spirit drink for consumption on the premises after 12:00 Noon on Sundays; request new Dance-Entertainment Permit; and request authorization for the outdoor sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

Section 501(2) of the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998, being MCL 436.1501(2) provides, in part: "...An application for a license to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, except in a city having a population of 750,000 or more, shall be approved by the local legislative body in which the applicant's place of business is located before the licensed is granted by the commission..."

The Commission finds that a resolution of disapproval adopted on April 20, 2009, by the Ann Arbor City Council, withdrawing its approval of the application made by HBSP Holdings Corp. for a new Class C license was received on April 23, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS THE COMMISSION THAT APPLICATION AS MADE BY HBSP HOLDINGS CORP. FOR A NEW CLASS C AND SPECIALLY DESIGNATED MERCHANT LICENSES WITH AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SPIRITS AND MIXED SPIRIT DRINK FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES AFTER 12:00 NOON ON SUNDAYS; REQUEST NEW DANCE-ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT; AND REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE OUTDOOR SALE, SERVICE, AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE LOCATED AT 401 E. LIBERTY, SUITE #2, ANN ARBOR, WASHTENAW COUNTY, BE DENIED, PURSUANT TO SECTION 501(2) OF THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE OF 1998, BEING MCL 436.1501(2) INASMUCH AS A RESOLUTION OF OBJECTION HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY.
