I have reviewed the proposed amendment in light of the Home Rule City Act, 1909 PA 279, MCL 117.1, et seq., and conclude that the proposed amendment is consistent with the Home Rule City Act.

The Attorney General has a separate responsibility to review proposed ballot language for compliance with the requirements of Section 21 of the Home Rule City Act, MCL 117.21. I have examined the ballot language for the proposed amendment as set forth in the City Council's resolution and conclude that the ballot language conforms to the requirements of Section 21 of the Home Rule City Act.
