

### Work Session Overview: Strategic Planning

- Strategic planning is an organization's process of defining its direction and making decisions on allocations of its resources to pursue this strategy.
- Strategic Planning Process (Forbes):
  - Determine where you are (internally and externally).
  - ► Identify what's important (Program and Project Initiatives/Funding Priorities).
  - ▶ Define what you must achieve (Measure(s) of Success).
  - Determine who is accountable.
  - Review. Review. Review

#### Externally-focused objectives

- Enable a safe, welcoming, and inclusive community.
- Ensure a financially stable City government.
- Promote responsible economic development.
- Protect the environment as responsible stewards of natural resources.
- Build and maintain sustainable infrastructure systems.
- Collaborate with community partners to enhance quality of life.

#### Internally-focused objectives

- Advance a strategic plan that embraces Ann Arbor's goals and values.
- Create a workplace of choice that inspires City staff to achieve excellence.

► Ensure proper use of City financial resources to meet current and future requirements.

#### Promote responsible economic development.

▶ Improve and enhance the City's standing as a reliable business partner.

## Protect the environment as responsible stewards of natural resources.

- Provide access to parks and open space and promote active lifestyles.
- Take positive steps toward implementing climate action goals.
- ▶ Improve approaches to solid waste management.
