You'll be receiving a notice from the city that we are applying for a zoning variance for the new house. This is due to a recent change in the zoning code.

In March 2017, we hired Dawn Zuber from Studio Z Architecture to design a wheelchair accessible house. It was designed to adhere to all of the city zoning rules on setbacks, which are the distance the house must be from the front, side, and rear property lines. The code allows accessory buildings (ie garages) to occupy up to 35% of the rear setback. Our house is designed with a rear facing attached garage which occupies 22% of the rear setback.

We recently learned that in July 2018, the zoning code was amended so that only detached accessory buildings can extend into the rear setback. Since our garage is attached, it no longer conforms to the updated code. We are applying for a variance to allow the garage to extend 7'2" into the rear setback. We'll be going in front of the zoning board in late January.
