## PROTEST PETITION CONCERNING THE REZONING OF 1320 SOUTH UNIVERSITY

On Friday October 9, 2009, the owners of 1320 South University (the "Owners") received notice that on October 19, 2009, the Ann Arbor City Council will hold a public hearing on the second reading of a zoning ordinance that in part proposes to rezone 1320 South University from the existing C2A classification to the new D2 zoning classification.

Pursuant to Section 125.3403(a) of the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act, MCL 125.3101 *et seq*, the Owners own 100% of the area of land included in the proposed change and therefore have standing to protest the rezoning. (See Attached Map) The Owners protest the rezoning of their land to D2 because the proposed zoning is unreasonable as applied to 1320 South University, will prevent the redevelopment of the land in an economically viable manner and is reverse spot zoning.

The Owners request that the City defer rezoning 1320 South University to D2 and instead consider rezoning the land to D1 or alternatively to D1 with conditions. Pursuant to MCL 125.3401(3), and under separate cover, the Owners have requested a hearing on the proposed rezoning for the purpose of offering such conditions for rezoning to D1.
