RESOLUTION TO APPROVE TRIANGLE TOWING STORAGE FACILITY SITE PLAN AND OHIO AVENUE AND A PORTION OF FEDERAL BOULEVARD STREET VACATION R-215-4-99

Whereas, Scott Snuverink has requested site plan approval for the development of a 166-vehicle storage facility and a garage with office space for the Triangle Towing business on Federal Boulevard, west of Stadium Boulevard;

Whereas, Scott Snuverink has requested that Ohio Avenue and a portion of Federal Boulevard be vacated;

Whereas, The Ann Arbor City Planning Commission, at its meeting of February 18, 1999, recommended approval of said requests; and

Whereas, The Ann Arbor City Council, on March 15, 1999, approved a resolution of intent to vacate these streets and hold a public hearing on the matter on April 19, 1999;

RESOLVED, That City Council approve the Triangle Towing Storage Facility Site Plan, subject to using only West Stadium to access the site and to providing parking aisles with a paved surface;

RESOLVED, That City Council approve the vacation of Ohio Avenue and a portion of Federal Boulevard, described below,

Ohio Avenue

Ohio Avenue right-of-way (66 feet wide), Bedford-Buttner Commercial Subdivision, Liber 16 of Plats, pages 8 and 9, Washtenaw County Records, Washtenaw County, Michigan.



Federal Boulevard

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 5, "Bedford-Buttner Commercial Subdivision," of part of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 31, T2S, R6E, City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 16 of Plats, pages 8 and 9, Washtenaw County Records; thence S 89°50'15" E 431.65 feet

along the Northerly right-of-way line of Federal Boulevard; thence continuing along said right-of-way line Easterly 187.29 feet along the arc of a 204.89 foot radius circular curve to the right, through a central angle of 52°22'29", having a chord which bears \$ 63°36'51" E 180.84 feet: thence S 52°34'23" W 66.00 feet to a point on the Southerly right-of-way line of Federal Boulevard; thence along said right-of-way line Westerly 126.96 feet along the arc of a 138.89 foot radius circular curve to the left, through a central angle of 52°22'29", having a chord which bears N 63°36'51" W 122.59 feet; thence N 89°50'15" W 431.64 feet continuing along said right-of-way line; thence N 00°11'31" E 66.00 feet to the Point of Beginning. Being a part of Federal Boulevard of said "Bedford-Buttner Commercial Subdivision," and containing 0.89 acres of land, more or less. Being subject to easements and restrictions of record, if any,

RESOLVED. That a 40-foot wide utility easement within the vacated portions be reserved; and

RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be recorded at the Washtenaw County Register of Deed's Office following approval of this resolution.
