Prevent FATAL AND SEVERE CRASHES



#### Ann Arbor and Vision Zero

- 2015 City Council accepted the Pedestrian Safety and Access Task Force recommendations and affirmed the Vision Zero goal of zero traffic fatalities by 2025.
- 2017 Vulnerable Road User ordinance
- 2017 City identifies 4 tiers of school safety improvements and starts implementing
- 2018 Gateway treatments and 35 RRFBs (list improvements)
- 2018 Changing Driver Behavior

#### Ann Arbor and Vision Zero

- 2018 A2 Be Safe Campaign
- 2018 Transportation Plan Update "Moving Together Towards Vision Zero" begins
- 2018 Streetlight funding and prioritization
- 2019 City implements a Crosswalk Design Guideline
- 2019 City inventories all major mid-block crosswalks
