Infrastructure update

Food truck rallies had a 79% diversion rate (report attached)

In 2019, Food Gatherers received 20,076 pounds of food from the Ann Arbor Farmers Market.
(compared to 34,376 lbs last year)

WIC and Senior Fresh programs complete.

2019 Women, Infants and Children - \$5,330 redeemed (2018 \$4,400)

2019 Senior Project Fresh - \$4,540 redeemed (2018 \$4,288)

In December, Slow Food Huron Valley will make mini grant available to farmers market vendors using funds received from farm to table dinner. Up to \$500 amounts for total of \$6200 – applications will be considered in rounds.
