The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) requires Ann Arbor to sample for lead and copper in water from at least 50 homes every three years. We are asking for your assistance in meeting this requirement. According to the information we have on file, your residence meets EGLE's criteria and we would greatly appreciate your participation in the sampling. COVID-19 Precautions: Non-contact procedures will be used for sampling. Sample kits will be disinfected prior to being dropped off at the home. Homeowners will take a sample according to provided instructions and then contact the City for sample pick up.
