



First Amendment to the Service Agreement Between Passport Labs, Inc. (formerly known as Complus Data Innovations, Inc.) and City of Ann Arbor

This Amendment ("Amendment") is made by and between Passport Labs, Inc. ("Passport"), formerly known as Complus Data Innovations, Inc., and the City of Ann Arbor ("City") (Passport and City are collectively referred to as the "Parties").

Reference is made to that certain Service Agreement ("Agreement") for municipal parking citation processing and collection services (RFP No. 849) dated September 26, 2013 by and between Passport") and the City.

The Parties desire to amend the Agreement as follows, which shall be effective as of the last date specified below the Parties' signatures:

- 1. The following language is hereby added to the end of the existing Section II Duration:

Following the initial extension of three (3) additional years, the Parties agree to extend the Agreement for an additional two (2) year term, effective through November 14, 2023. Thereafter, the Agreement shall automatically renew for successive, one (1) year periods unless either Party provides written notice of intent not to renew at least three hundred sixty five (365) days prior to each renewal date.

- 2. Except as expressly amended herein, the remainder of the Agreement remains in full force and effect.
