## AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ANN ARROR

The following sections of the Bylaws of The Economic Development Corporation of the City of Ann Arbor are hereby amended in accordance with Section 30 of Act 338, Public Acts of Michigan, 1974, as amended, to provide as follows:

Article III, Section 2. Number, Tenure and Qualifications. The Board of Directors shall consist of nine eleven persons including nine voting members, not more than three of whom shall be an officer or employee of the City of Ann Arbor, and up to two non-voting members.

Article III, Section 2. Quorum. A majority of the members of the Board of Directors then in office constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board of Directors, provided, that if less than majority of the directors are present at a meeting, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice. The vote of the majority of members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present constitutes the action of the Board of Directors, unless the vote of a larger number is required by statutes, the articles of incorporation or these by-laws. Amendment of the by-laws by the Board of Directors requires the vote of not less than a majority of the members of the Board then in office. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any non-voting member shall not be taken into account for purposes of determining the presence of a quorum.
