## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING HOSFORD REZONING (2260 TRAVER ROAD)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 3, 2021 to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-21-11 – Hosford Rezoning. This ordinance would rezone 3.56 Acres from TWP (Township District) to R1B (Single-Family Dwelling District), 2260 Traver Road.

The proposal would amend the City Zoning Map, which is a part of Section 5:10.2 of Chapter 55, Title V of the Ann Arbor City Code.

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5.10.2 of Chapter 55 (Unified Development Code) of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Unified Development Code, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:

Beginning at the ¼ Section Corner between Sections 15 and 16 of Township 2 South, Range 6 East, Ann Arbor Township, Washtenaw County, State of Michigan; thence N87 degrees 41'11"E 224.75 feet (recorded as N88 degrees 224.75 feet (recorded as Not degrees 05'00"E) along the East-West ¼ line of said Section 15 to a point on the concrete wall of a small dam; thence S04 degrees 01'08"E 5.00 feet (recorded as S03 degrees 40'30"E) to a found 1" iron pipe; thence S04 degrees 01'08"E 325.00 feet (recorded as S03 degrees 40'30"E) to a found iron pipe; thence S86 degrees 03'52"W 496.67 feet (recorded as \$86 degrees 24'30"W 496.83 feet); thence N07 degrees 14'38"E 341.34 feet (recorded as N07 degrees 38'00"E 343.21 feet) along the centerline of Traver Road as monumented; thence N85 degrees 38'58"E 205.35 feet (recorded as N86 degrees 27'30"E) along the East-West ¼ line of said Section 16 to the Place of Beginning, being a part of the Southwest 14 of said Section 15 and the Southeast 14 of said Section 16 and containing 3.56 acres of land, more or less.

Parcel 2: I-09-15-340-001 in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan as R1B (Single-Family Dwelling) district.
