SUBJECT: Proposed Planning Commission By-Laws Updates

PROPOSED CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MOTION

The Ann Arbor City Planning Commission moves to approve the By-Laws as presented.

STAFF REPORT

As stipulated in the current version of the Planning Commission By-Laws, annual review and consideration of the By-Laws is required. In 2020, the Planning Commission approved a revised version of By-Laws, which were not sent forward to City Council after adoption. The proposed version here reflects the previously adopted changes as the starting draft, and additional amendments for your consideration now are tracked in the document. The proposed changes include:

- Replacing “Master Plan” with “Comprehensive Plan”
- Removing Introductions as a standard agenda item.
- Changing membership attendance expectations to match language of other recently approved commission by-laws, with modifications to reflect a higher annual volume of Planning Commission meetings than many other board and commissions.
