I also frankly much prefer to drive on configurations like this vs. 4 lanes without a turn lane, since it reduces the chaos of lane changes and sudden stops due to other people turning.

I looked this morning during rush hour to see if there were traffic backups reported, and google had nothing of note, which was confirmed by a friend who lives on Main. I suspect the traffic issues last week were due to student move-in and people getting used to the new configuration, and I'm confident that this was a good choice. I hope this configuration becomes permanent, at least until we find a way to install a protected cycle track.
