ORDINANCE NO. ORD-10-26 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT (INCREASE FINES, REGULATING OWNER FINE CHARGE BACK TO OCCUPANTS AND CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES)

Section 7.4 of the Ann Arbor City Charter authorizes the publication by summary of ordinances over 500 words in length.

The following is a summary of Ordinance No. ORD-10-26:

Ordinance No. ORD-10-26 amends Section 2:12 and 2:13 of Chapter 26 to broaden responsibility for ensuring solid waste on a property is properly stored, extends the "look back period" for determining prior offenses to encourage long-term compliance, clarifies who is responsible for compliance expanding the set of persons liable for tickets in an effort to incentivize tenants, occupants and agents to maintain the property, expands notice provisions and increases fines for first and subsequent offenses.

The ordinance will take effect on the tenth day following legal publication.
