H-2 Market Enterprise Fund Update

The Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) is changing the way the City of Ann Arbor accounts for pension liability. This change will affect all enterprise funds throughout the city, including the Market Fund.

In addition to the pension liability impact that would affect the market financially beginning in Fiscal Year 2015, which begins July 1, 2014, the Market fund has expenses in excess of revenues due to increasing costs for programs, inspections, and the operation of the evening market. The market has also experienced a decline in revenue due to lower returns on investment income and the change in parking revenue received by the Downtown Development Authority. The combined effects of these situations has led city administrators to begin discussions of moving the market budget into the general parks fund, rather than maintaining it as an enterprise fund.
