commissioners discussed ongoing need for education regarding available parking in the area close to the market. Further discussion will be had with city staff at the Downtown Development Authority to identify potential strategies for this outreach. Commission Goetz expressed vendor concern for the potential closing of Detroit Street.

Commissioner Santacroce emphasized the need to alleviate congestion (car and pedestrian) on 4th Avenue where market vendors often set up during busy market days. Detroit Street closure is viewed as a way to alleviate that congestion.

Commissioners discussed the need for loading zones for customers to pick up items and drop off family members at market entrances.

Market Manager Sarah DeWitt will report to the commission on next steps after speaking with city staff and the Downtown Development Authority.

Priorities among customers and vendors highlight need for extension of more formal stalls down the middle aisleway of the market. Commissioners would like to explore options for the construction of a building to accomodate vendors year-round in addition to potential community space on a second level of said building.
