- \* 3 Projects are not good candidates:
  - ■MF-CB-16-07 Commercial Corridors (Non-DDA) Street Framework Plan
    - •This is just a plan, not a project.
  - ■UT-WS-12-08 Superior Dam Concrete Repairs
    - Federal funds, and repairs.

- \* 2 Projects require followup:
  - ■MF-CB-16-06 Allen Creek Greenway Master Plan
    - Commissioner Rizzolo-Brown met with Connie P., right now its only in the planning stage. We will continue to monitor it.
