Solid Waste Program Discussion

Councilmember Smith reported on a discussion he has had with the City Administrator about the Solid Waste Plan Fund Balance. The City Administrator has recalculated the Fund Balance's projected size and found a several million dollar difference between his calculations and what was presented to the Commission last year. He will be coming to the February Commission meeting to present his findings. Several Commissioners expressed frustration at how solid waste issues have been handled internally.

Discussion about appointing a Solid Waste Plan Steering Subcommittee

There was a motion put forth by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Mirsky to create a small short-term Subcommittee with the goal of providing recommendations for what should be included in the Solid Waste Plan RFP and to participate in reviewing and interviewing consultant teams replying to that RFP. Commissioners Smith, Skinner, Hutton, and Hannah expressed interest in serving on this Subcommittee.

REPORT FROM COMMITTEES AND CHAIR

Review of Recommendations from the Metrics Subcommittee

Commissioner Mirsky spoke about a "Wins and Disappointments" report he pulled together reviewing the previous year. He and staff Josh MacDonald also gave a short presentation about the 38 indicators in the Sustainability Framework metrics dashboard and received feedback from the Commission. The Commissioners recommended a number of additional things to consider and investigate, including talking to City staff and nonprofits working in the related goal area of the Sustainability

Framework Dashboard for their input. The two committed to circle back to the Commission with final proposals in 2-3 months. Video for this item runs from 1:09:08 to 2:24:36.
