# C-1 Project Update - Environmental Assessment

The Airport Manager reported that the City is still working with an outside consultant to finalize a scope of work and pricing to provide assistance in completing the revised draft Environmental Assessment for the proposed Runway Safety Extension Project. The FAA has provided input on the proposed scope of work to ensure their targets are being addressed as well. Once the scope and pricing are finalized, the grant agreement must be approved by the Michigan Aeronautics Commission before it is sent to the City for consideration.

#### C-2 Other Items

The Airport Manager updated the Committee on the winter conditions at the airport and the new use of FICON Notams. While it has already been an active winter, the crews are doing an excellent job of keeping the airfield in useable condition. There have been some equipment issues recently but we have utilized backup equipment, some that was recently purchased through grant funds, to address the problem.
