Allen Haber, Address Unknown, discussed the lack of affordable housing within the City.

Ackerman discussed the intention of premiums and making adjustments to reflect the needs of present day Ann Arbor.

Lenart explained that Floor Area Ratio is a massing measurement for building square footage.

Lenart, Ackerman, and DiLeo discussed payment in lieu as an option for affordable housing, parking, building height, premiums, finishes, and unlikely scenarios.

Commissioner Julie Weatherbee discussed methods used by the City of Boulder Colorado for implementing affordable housing.

Commissioner Scott Trudeau inquired about FAR calculations and other possibilities for calculations.

DiLeo explained that other methods were discussed at the Ordinance Revisions Committee meeting.

Commissioner Erica Briggs discussed that an increase in smaller units is a benefit over no new units, and parking costs associated with affordable units.

Commissioner Lisa Sauve discussed affordable housing in recent developments, the positive aspects of worst case scenarios, and parking.

Lenart provided information on a current proposed development.

The Commission discussed simplifying the language around determining premiums and calculating FAR.

The Commission discussed needing more time for options to be presented.
