# 21-1950 Resolution recommending Ann Arbor City Council authorize a Municipal Feasibility Study and initiate work towards creation of a Municipal Sustainable Energy Utility

- •Specify that the rate analysis for the SEU should be completed in the 6th clause and consider removing the SEU from the second resolved clause
- •Revisit the idea of combining lots of thoughts and moving parts in the second clause
- •Consider having two resolutions: one resolution on SEU; one resolution on traditional study
- •Interest in identifying who makes decisions, who controls budget, who has authority
- •Consider editing first resolved clause to use stage gate approach common in industry as way to frame what is desired
- •Alternatively, consider keeping existing language about what is included in a traditional municipal feasibility study
- •Alternatively, consider moving the language about what is included in a traditional municipal feasibility study to a Whereas clause earlier in the document
- •Consideration of whether or not an options analysis should be included. Discussion about whether we tell them to analyze specific options or leave it open to the contractor and their expertise. Interest in having the contractor outline their perceived best path forward
- •UM has a model for an RFP that might be useful used by the PCCN

Commissioner Clevey motioned to merge the two resolved clauses to read:

RESOLVED, that the Ann Arbor Energy Commission recommends that the Ann Arbor City Council authorize and fund a study to analyze and propose multiple potential pathways the City could take to meet its A2ZERO energy-related emissions reduction and clean energy goals.

Commissioner Joerg seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
