Resolution to Authorize Summary Publication of Ordinance No. ORD-11-04 - An Ordinance to Add a New Chapter 95 to Title VII (Medical Marijuana Licenses for Dispensaries) of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor

The attached resolution authorizes the summary publication of Ordinance No. ORD-11-04 that adds a new Chapter 95 to the Ann Arbor City Code, which would require medical marijuana dispensaries to be licensed by the City and to adhere to regulations contained in Chapter 95. The City Charter contains provisions to allow summary publications of ordinances that are in excess of 500 words in length. The purpose of this resolution is to lessen the City’s cost resulting from the required publication of the revisions to the City Code.
