The attached resolution is requesting approval to close North University between Thayer and Fletcher for the University of Michigan Center for Campus Involvement’s Festifall Event on Thursday, September 1, 2022 from 10:00 AM until 11:00 PM. The actual event will take place between 2:30 PM until 8:30 PM. The remaining time will be used for presentations, set-up and breakdown. The entire community is invited to participate. As such, the event site and common spaces will be accessible to normal, public pedestrian and emergency traffic.
