Whereas, BSB Communications, Inc is extending pricing for the Mitel Assurance Support through Sourcewell Contract# 0022719-MBS;

Whereas, BSB is ranked the #1 Mitel Dealer in Michigan and #12 in the US;

Whereas, Staying up to date on support and software upgrades for the Mitel phone system is crucial and necessary to keep the Mitel phone system operational for the daily operations and for the safety and security of the employees of the City of Ann Arbor;

Whereas, Funding for the Mitel phone system annual support is budgeted for and available in the approved FY 2025 Information Technology Fund budget; and

Whereas, BSB Communications, Inc. complies with the requirements of the City's Non-Discrimination and Living Wage ordinances;
