Resolution to Approve Changes to Bylaws of the Ann Arbor City Planning Commission The Ann Arbor City Planning Commission recommends approval of the attached amended bylaws. Article VII, Section 16 of the bylaws were amended to change the advance notice required for special accommodations from 24 hours to two business days, consistent with recent changes in procedure by the City Clerk's Office. These amended bylaws were approved by the City Planning Commission at its meeting of July 16, 2013. The changes have been reviewed by the City Attorney's Office, consistent with Council Resolution R-08-496.
