Resolution to Approve Street Closings for the 2016 Ann Arbor Art Fairs - July 20, 2016 at 6:00 A.M. Through July 25, 2016 at 6:00 A.M.

The 2016 Ann Arbor Art Fairs are scheduled for Thursday, July 21 to Sunday, July 24 2016. The Ann Arbor Art Fairs have been held Wednesday through Saturday. The event is sponsored by five separate organizations, each covering separate but adjacent portions of downtown Ann Arbor. Each organization will be providing insurance in accordance with the City's requirements for use of the public right-of-way.

The annual resolution closes streets and allows temporary outdoor sales within the public right-ofway. Consideration of the resolution is recommended at this time to provide sufficient notification of the 2016 Ann Arbor Art Fairs moving to a Thursday to Sunday if City Council approves. Approval of the resolution is recommended.

Whereas, The 2016 Ann Arbor Art Fair dates are July 21 through 24, 2016 and the four Art Fair organizations, the Main Street Area Association and the Washtenaw Non-Profits have requested street closings and related services from the City to permit a successful event;

RESOLVED, That City Council approve the following streets be closed, barricaded, and parking be prohibited from Wednesday, July 20, 2016 at 6:00 A.M. through Monday, July 25, 2016 at 6:00 A.M. for the 2016 Ann Arbor Art Fair:

- <u>LIBERTY STREET</u> from South Ashley to South State Street; Ashley Street, Fourth Avenue, Fifth Avenue and Division Street will remain open to through traffic. The Washtenaw Non-Profits will occupy Liberty Street between Fifth Avenue and 200 feet west of Division Street.
- <u>NORTH UNIVERSITY</u> from Fletcher to South State Street.

- <u>THAYER STREET</u>, from North University, including the North University intersection, to East Washington.
- <u>EAST WASHINGTON STREET</u> from South State Street to Fletcher
- <u>SOUTH MAIN STREET</u> from the south side of Huron Street to the north side of William Street; Huron, Washington, and William Streets will remain open to traffic.
- <u>SOUTH STATE STREET</u> from East Washington Street to Madison.
- <u>SOUTH UNIVERSITY</u> from State to South Forest.
- <u>EAST UNIVERSITY</u> from South University Avenue to Willard Street.
- <u>CHURCH STREET</u> from Willard Street to the entrance of the University of Michigan Church Street parking structure.
- <u>MAYNARD STREET</u> from Liberty Street to Jefferson.
- <u>JEFFERSON</u> from Maynard Street to Thompson.
- <u>WILLIAM STREET</u> from State Street to Thompson. The barricade at Thompson will be staffed by Art Fair members at all times.
- <u>THOMPSON</u> from Liberty Street to the parking structure entrance/exit.
