Whereas, Recommendations of approval or denial of claims and/or settlements in excess of \$5,000.00 by the Board of Insurance Administration are submitted to City Council for approval;

Whereas, The Board of Insurance Administration considered at its meeting on October 27, 2016, and recommends approval of a worker's compensation redemption settlement for Anthony Fischer a former employee, for worker's compensation payments for an on the job injury in the amount not to exceed \$55,000.00 for redemption of his worker's compensation claim; and

Whereas, The amount of this worker's compensation redemption settlement had been agreed to in principle pending City Council approval;

RESOLVED, That the Board of Insurance Administration's recommended approval of the worker's compensation redemption settlement for Anthony Fischer in the amount not to exceed \$55,000.00 at its October 27, 2016 meeting be approved.
