Resolution to Amend the Starting Time for the Rock the District Event on Saturday, April 22, 2017
A Resolution approving the closing of Maynard Street between Liberty and William was approved on February 21, 2017 at R-17-042. This event is currently scheduled to take place from Noon to Midnight. The organizers would like to adjust the time to close the street at 10:00 AM due to the scheduled March for Science, which starts at noon that day. The participants in the March will be walking down Liberty Street, so an earlier street closure of Maynard will ensure that set-up can take place without interfering with the other activities.

Whereas, a Resolution to Approve the Closing of Maynard Street for the Rock the District on April 22, 2017 from 12:00 Noon until Midnight was approved by City Council at R-17-042;

Whereas, The Rock the District organizers would like to close Maynard Street between Liberty and William at 10:00 AM instead of Noon so as not to conflict with the March for Science, scheduled to begin at Noon that day;

RESOLVED, That City Council approve the time change of the street closure of Maynard between Liberty and William for the Rock the District event from 10:00 AM, ending at midnight.
