- E. Madison Street from S. State Street to Thompson Street
- Thompson Street from E. Madison Street to E. William Street
- E. William Street from Thompson Street to S. Fourth Ave.
- S Fourth Ave. from E. William Street to E. Liberty Street
- E. Liberty Street from S. Fourth Ave. to S. State Street
- S. State Street from E. Liberty Street to the UM Diag
