Resolution to Approve the Professional Services Agreement with Rosati, Schultz, Joppich, & Amtsbuechler P.C., for Legal Services Relative to Trinitas Development, LLC (\$150,000.00) (8 Votes Required)

Trinitas Development, LLC has filed a claim of appeal against the City following City Council's denial of the Cottages at Barton Green Site Plan;

The City Attorney selected the Rosati, Schultz, Joppich, & Amtsbuechler P.C., law firm to provide legal advice regarding this claim of appeal. The selection is based on the firm's familiarity with the issues and the firm's experience and expertise.
