Proclamation Recognizing Roger Moon as Volunteer of the Month for July 2019

PROCLAMATION

In Appreciation of Roger Moon
July 1, 2019

WHEREAS, Roger Moon has dedicated himself to volunteering in the assistance of rain gardens in the Ann Arbor Parks and Natural Area Preservation; and

WHEREAS, Roger Moon has worked with the GIVE 365 Volunteer Program, Natural Area Preservation, and Washtenaw County Water Quality Specialists for the past 4 years, dedicating over 1000 service hours. He has adopted several public rain gardens, has assisted staff in maintenance efforts in public and private workdays in 15 Natural Areas; and
