Resolution to Authorize Summary Publication of Ordinance No. 09-25 to Amend Section 1:17 of Chapter 1 (Code Violation Citations - ROW Enforcement) of Title I of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor for the Public Services Project Management Unit

The attached resolution authorizes the summary publication of Ordinance No. 09-25 to amend Section 1:17 of Chapter 1 of Title I of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor.

The City Charter contains provisions to allow summary publications of ordinances that are in excess of 500 words in length. The purpose of this resolution is to lessen the City's cost resulting from the required publication of the revisions to the City Code.

RESOLVED, That Ordinance No. 09-25 be published by the following summary:

Ordinance No. 09-25 amends Section 1:17 of Chapter 1 of Title I of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor to allow Project Management Services Unit staff to enforce the Code as they did previously, including the updated formal titles of the staff who will enforce the Code.
