Resolution to Approve Professional Legal Services Agreement with Reiser and Dawid, P.L.L.C. to Provide Legal Representation as Court-appointed Counsel to Indigent Defendants. (\$62,432.16) Attached for your review and approval is a resolution to approve a Professional Legal Services Agreement with Reiser and Dawid, P.L.L.C. to provide legal representation to indigent persons charged with misdemeanor offenses, who appear in the 15<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court judges' courtrooms.

<u>Budget/Fiscal Impact</u>: Funds for these services are available in the approved FY21 Court budget. No additional funding is requested at this time.

The 15th Judicial District Court is required by law to appoint attorneys to represent indigent defendants when potential sanctions, including sanctions for violations of court orders, upon conviction may include incarceration. Reiser & Dawid, P.L.L.C. has experience providing these services.

The proposed Agreement is for a three-month period, July 1, 2020, through September 30, 2020. This Agreement will cover the timeframe between the start of City FY21 and the end of the current Michigan Indigent Defense Commission grant.

RESOLVED, That City Council approve the attached Professional Legal Services Agreement with Reiser and Dawid, P.L.L.C. to provide Court-appointed counsel for indigent defendants appearing in the 15th Judicial District Court in the amount of \$62,432.16;

RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to execute the Agreement following approval as to form by the City Attorney and as to substance by the City Administrator; and

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator take all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution including execution of any documents or amendments that do not exceed the amounts authorized herein.
