Resolution to Amend the Emergency Purchase Order with Waste Management, Inc. for the Dexter Avenue Improvements Project (\$7,500.00)

The attached resolution amends the Purchase Order to Waste Management for additional landfilling of contaminated soil excavated during the Dexter Avenue Improvements Project.

In November 2012, Council ratified the City Administrator's authorization of a \$45,000.00 emergency purchase order to Waste Management to provide landfilling of contaminated soil (R-12-519) encountered during excavations for the Dexter Avenue road and utility work.

At that time, staff estimated future excavations would yield about 1200 tons in addition to the 3000 tons excavated. This was based on the location of the soils on the south side of the road and the expectation that the north side would mirror the south. However, the north side produced more contaminated soil than estimated. The actual tonnage exceeded 5000 tons. Therefore, staff recommends increasing the purchase order by \$7,500 to cover this additional landfilling and any potential future landfilling that may be required during the final stages of the project (this includes completion of the Vets Parking lot and bioretention area).

We propose to fund this purchase order from the existing budget of the Dexter Avenue Improvements Project.

Whereas, Soil with a petroleum-type odor was encountered during excavations for the Dexter Avenue Improvements Project;

Whereas, This soil needed to be properly landfilled;

Whereas, Waste Management, Inc. was selected as the destination landfill based on the tipping fee cost;

Whereas, In November 2012, City Council ratified the City Administrator's approval of an emergency purchase order with Waste Management for \$45,000.00;

Whereas, The amount of the purchase order was based on staff's estimate of the future tonnage expected and the actual tonnage exceeded this estimate; and

Whereas, Sufficient funds exist in the Dexter Avenue Improvements Project budget;

RESOLVED, That the purchase order with Waste Management, Inc. in the amount of \$45,000.00 for disposal of the affected soil be amended by \$7,500.00 for a total of \$52,500.00; and

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator be authorized to take all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
