Resolution Appointing R4C and R2A Zoning District Study Advisory Committee Whereas, On March 2, 2009, City Council directed the City Planning Commission and Planning staff to work with the public to provide the City Council with a report and recommendations for potential ordinance changes to certain residential zoning districts found in the Central Area;

Whereas, On July 6, 2009, City Council directed that an R4C and R2A Zoning District Study (R4C & R2A Study) Advisory Committee be appointed to work closely with City staff throughout the course of the community outreach effort; advising on the outreach strategy, reviewing assumptions and providing feedback at important project milestones; and
