

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing on the following items will be held by the Ann Arbor City Planning Commission at the County Building, 220 North Main Street, Board of Commissioners Public Conference Room, Ann Arbor, Michigan on Tuesday, February 8, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.

The City of Ann Arbor has completed a draft update to the Parks and Recreation Open Space Plan (PROS Plan). The Plan is an element of the City's master plan and the City's vision for parks and recreation in Ann Arbor. The Plan provides an inventory of existing parks and facilities, describes the relationship between the Parks and Recreation system and surrounding municipalities and recreational providers, identifies parks and recreation needs and deficiencies, and proposes major capital park projects for existing and new parks. The document was last updated in 2006.

At this hearing, the City Planning Commission will consider all comments from persons wishing to provide them before recommending adoption of the plan. The City Council also will hold a public hearing at a later date and make a decision on adoption of the plan.
