ORDINANCE NO. ORD-22-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 5.16.1.A, 5.16.2.A, 5.16.2.B, 5.16.3.J, 5.16.3.P, 5.16.4.B, 5.16.6.C, 5.16.6.G, AND TO REPEAL AND REPLACE SECTION 5.19 OF CHAPTER 55 (UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE) OF TITLE V OF CODE OF THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR – (AMEND PARKING STANDARDS)

The City Charter allows summary publication of ordinances that are in excess of 500 words in length:

Ordinance No. 22-13 amends Sections 5.16.1.A, 5.16.2.A, 5.16.2.B, 5.16.3.J, 5.16.3.P, 5.16.4.B, 5.16.6.C, 5.16.6.G, and repeals and replaces Section 5.19 Of Chapter 55 (Unified Development Code) of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor. The amendments will eliminate minimum vehicular parking requirements across the City, establish maximum vehicular parking limits in the TC1 Zoning District, and modify requirements and applicability for electric vehicle parking spaces.

The effective date of the Ordinance is 10 days after publication.
