Hi dear commission members,

I am here to propose that we need to change all the traffic lights to yellow lights on primary roads and flashing red lights on secondary streets between 11:00pm to 6:00am. A specific time frame can be discussed.

While I am on the street during that time frame, many times I have to wait for the light to turn green, but there were no cars on another street. Usually that takes up to 2 minutes if it is not at the smart sensor installed intersection. It causes unnecessary time and gas. I believe you all may have a similar experience. If we can make that change, it won't cost too much to do it but makes the street more efficient.

I notice that many other cities already adopt this method. It does save a lot of time for people who travel at night.

I wish the committee could discuss that and make it happen. So the residents will benefit from your decision.
