 No parking allowed on the 800 block of Monroe Street between Tappan & Oakland

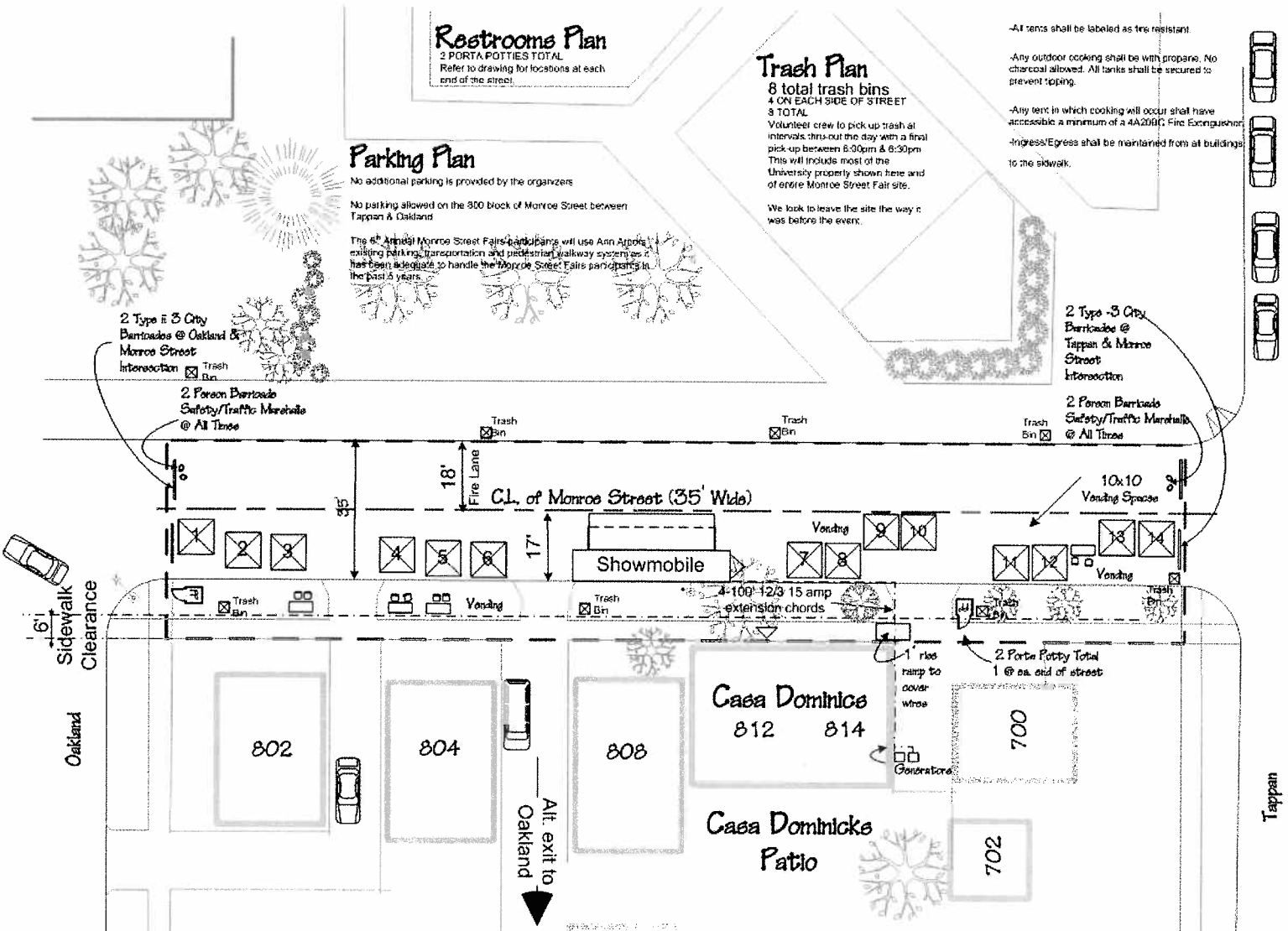

2 Type II 3 City Barricades @ Oakland & Monroe Street Intersection

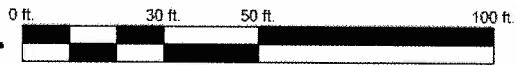
2 Person Barricade Safety/Traffic Marshals @ All Times
