NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TALPOS-KNIGHT PROPERTY (2731 NEWPORT ROAD)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on March 15, 2021, to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-21-01 — Talpos-Knight Rezoning. This ordinance would rezone 1.3 Acres from TWP (Township District) to R1A (Single-Family District), Talpos-Knight Rezoning, at 2731 Newport Road.

The proposal would amend the City Zoning Map, which is a part of Section 5:10.2 of Chapter 55, Title V of the Ann Arbor City Code.

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5.10.2 of Chapter 55 of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Chapter 55, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:

Commencing at the North 1/4 corner of Section 18; thence North 89°32'30" East 43.16 feet; thence South 26°33'30" East 362.55 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 65°23' West 279.16 feet; thence South 02°16'36" East 173.97 feet; thence North 65°23' East 350.74 feet; thence North 26°33'30' West 161 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Being part of the North 1/2 of Section 18, Town 2 South, Range 6 East

in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan as R1A (Single-Family Zoning District).

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after ten days from legal publication.
