

NO PARKING TUESDAY PROGRAM
November 2007 Survey

The survey card requested to know if
YES, I am satisfied with the “No Parking Tuesday” Program; or
NO, I am not satisfied with the “No Parking Tuesday” Program

Baldwin Place (4): (100% response from 4 residents)

3 YES = 75% (or 75% of 4 residents on Baldwin Place)

- It would be nice if no tickets were issued after the trash pickup. That is, once residents take notice that the trucks have been through, we could again park curbside.

1 NO = 25% (or 25% of 4 residents on Baldwin Place)

- No parking lasts too late – can’t park at house after work. 8-3 might be ok.

Baldwin Avenue (26): (8 addresses or 31% of residents did not respond)

1 NO RESPONSE = 5% (or 4% of 26 residents on Baldwin Avenue)

10 YES = 56% (or 38% of 26 residents on Baldwin Avenue)

- This has definitely cut down on the parking congestion on Baldwin
- Yes, this works well & the City employees can efficiently take care of trash & recycling
- Very satisfied
- Would have program just until 3-4pm. 6pm is too late. (after school childcare)

7 NO = 39% (or 27% of 26 residents on Baldwin Avenue)

- Leaf pick-up has not been scheduled on Tuesday, so our leaves were not cleared
- Absolutely hate it! Have not seen any improved services, but have (guests, workers & us) racked up a number of expensive tickets! Hate it! Hate it! Hate it!
- I received a \$25 ticket when I parked after the trash had been picked up and a friend recently received a ticket at 5:45pm. This was definitely a “money raising” ticket at that hour of the day.
- We have very few cars parked on our street so it doesn’t seem necessary. It would be better to post no-parking for leaf pick-up days.
- It is neither helpful, convenient, nor necessary. Please remove this program.
- It doesn’t have much affect on street cleaning on this end of street.

Wells Street (11): (5 residents or 45% of residents did not respond)

2 YES = 3% (or 18% of 11 residents on Wells Street)

- Please canvas neighbors again about 2-hr/resident parking!

4 NO = 67% (or 36% of 11 residents on Wells Street)

- We have a shared driveway and two cars causing an inconvenience of having to park in 2 hour parking. Perhaps a waiver to park all day

Tuesday in 2 hour parking would help. Thanks. (11/16 – called & explained program waiver ---B)

- **What is the point besides revenue collection? Doesn't correspond to leaf collection. Trash/recycling trucks often come before no parking is in force. I haven't noticed a correlation with street cleaning & Tuesdays...**
- **While I like the fact that the trash/recycling collectors have a clear street, I find visitors, workmen, plumbers, my piano students are inconvenienced getting tickets without enough warning unless I call them in advance. But I think the whole system should be abolished not just partially. Because if other streets keep the restrictions & ours not restricted anymore, then refugee cars will come to block my street from theirs.**
- **I do not see any difference – the streets are never cleaned on those days & there is little difference on my street.**
