# AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO CITY OF ANN ARBOR 2023-2024 HUMAN SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE SHELTER ASSOCIATION OF WASHTENAW COUNTY FOR 2023-24 WINTER EMERGENCY SHELTER AND WARMING CENTER RESPONSE

This Amendment Number 1 ("Amendment") is to the 2023-2024 Human Service Contract between the City of Ann Arbor, ("City") and the Shelter Association of Washtenaw County, ("Contractor") for the 2023-24 Winter Emergency Shelter and Warming Center Response dated November 1, 2023 ("Agreement").

City and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

The following replaces Section 2 "Budget" in its entirety, and replaces Attachment 2 with Attachment 2A:
